Eligibility:

- Land must be within the SRWD
- Only one application per registered landowner will be accepted
- Applications will be assessed on soil class, erosion risk, and proximity to water

Cost Sharing:

• SRWD will pay 50% of seed costs to a maximum of \$500 per application

General Terms & Conditions:

- The annual projects resulting from this program will be subject to funds appropriate
- Subject to the terms, the Agreement shall become effective and shall be binding upon both parties until terminated
- Failure to comply to any of the said terms and conditions may negate the landowner's eligibility to participate in further SRWD programs

Landowner Responsibility:

- Submitted completed application
- Landowner must purchase the seed, Common #1 or better
- Sow seed on the land specified in the application & within the year of delivery
- Provide proof of purchase after seeding with all receipts submitted by July 15th
- Provide consent of entry onto property for inspection, evaluation, and educational tours
- Shall not sell, trade, or exchange seed
- Must keep forge in the production for 4 growing seasons after establishment
- If land ownership changes, the new owner shall comply with the application, or return the seed or funding amount to the SRWD

Watershed District Responsibility:

- Determine the Landowner/District cost share formula according to the number of applicants
- Reimburse applicants for appropriate share following receipt of original paid invoices and seed tags
- Reserve the right to reasonable access to project site for the purpose of inspection& educational tours
