- There is no limit to the number of applications that a landowner can make to this program
- The property must be in SRWD

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

General Terms & Conditions:

- Projects applied for must be within the SRWD
- Failure of landowner to meet Landowner Responsibilities may negate him/her from other Watershed District Programs

Landowner Responsibility:

- Provide consent of access to property for planting and inspection
- Prepare and mark the area prior to planting day
- Establish grass and mow between rows, and provide watering if necessary
- Protect plantings from livestock, chemical, insect, or fire damage
- Check with the RM regarding set back distance from road allowance if needed
- Replants in the following years are the landowners responsibility

Watershed District Responsibility:

- The right to refuse an application due to the unsuitable site location or distance from main buildings.
(The SRWD follows PRFA guidelines for distance set back from buildings of **100ft**)
